Introduction courses are for people who are new to improv and Intermediate courses are for those with more experience.

"The nice thing about an improv class is that anyone can take it and have a great time," said DiAngelo. "The fundamentals of improv carry over into any walk of life. Classes can promote self-esteem, confidence, a renewed sense of play, teamwork, and positivity. It's also a great tool for stand-up comics, public speakers, and traditional actors."
